

LONG ISLAND CRISIS CENTER PROVIDES 24/7 FREE, HIGH QUALITY, CONFIDENTIAL AND NON-JUDGMENTAL PROGRAMS AND SERVICES TO SUPPORT AND EMPOWER LONG ISLANDERS AT CRITICAL TIMES IN THEIR LIVES.

FOUNDED IN 1971 AS A SUICIDE PREVENTION AND CRISIS INTERVENTION AGENCY, THE CRISIS CENTER HAS A LONG HISTORY OF BEING ON THE CUTTING EDGE OF ISSUES THAT CHALLENGE THE WELL-BEING AND MENTAL HEALTH OF OUR COMMUNITY. NEW PROGRAMS AND INITIATIVES ARE CREATED TO PROVIDE SUPPORT, COUNSELING, RESOURCES AND REFERRALS AND RAISE PUBLIC AWARENESS OF UNDERSERVED, AT-RISK AND/OR DISENFRANCHISED POPULATIONS ON LONG ISLAND.

### **DEAR FRIENDS,**

2016 marks 45 years of service to the Long Island community—made possible by your generosity, your philanthropy and your belief that by working together we can have a positive impact on the lives of those in crisis. We are proud to recognize our 45 Lifesaving Circle of Friends and our almost two hundred dedicated volunteers. Together, we can celebrate the support and hope that we have given to 1 million Long Islanders over these past 45 years.

This Annual Report gives us the opportunity to let you know how much we have grown to meet the ever-changing needs of our community:

- Our Building Healthy Lives Through Education program brought workshops on-site to schools and reached 21,713 students and professional staff. For the first time, Cyber Bullying Awareness was the most requested workshop testament to our responsiveness to what is a trending need in the community;
- Pride for Youth delivered 7,965 client services with the Coffeehouse (on Friday evenings) seeing a dramatic increase in attendance, as LGBTQ youth sought a safe and secure environment to meet and socialize;
- Family & Friends Healing Together, a support group and space for those who have lost a loved one to suicide, was launched—as increasing suicide rates took its toll on many Long Island families;
- Young Latinas: Girls at Risk Initiative produced three bilingual brochures for teen girls, parents and school districts educating the communities about suicide prevention strategies;
- A Wall of Remembrance was introduced at the annual Let's Walk, Let's Talk ....Stepping Together to Prevent Suicide Walk to provide a space for families and friends to honor and memorialize loved ones lost to suicide. • • •

We are also proud to report that our 2016 Financial Audit shows that 88 cents of every dollar donated goes towards services and programs.

As we look towards the future, we know there is still more to be done. We also know that with your continued support together we can make a difference.



"You are a lifesaver!"

A husband and wife called with concerns about their 15 yearold son who was spiraling out of control. He was abusing alcohol and marijuana. The Counselor responded with immediate assistance by contacting the Mobile Crisis Unit for their son and gave referrals to the parents to help them cope.

A 33 year-old male called and said that he heard the devil's voice telling him to kill himself by jumping in front of a LIRR train. The Counselor gained the client's trust and offered to call 911 on his behalf. The client agreed. A few minutes later, the police arrived and informed the Counselor that they had found the client and would get him help.



A 17 year-old female approached the Community Educator after a Self-Injury Awareness workshop and told her that she stopped selfinjuring a year ago after cutting for three years. The girl began to cry and said that she had been OK until the past week when she had been thinking about self-injuring again. Her parents were pressuring her to decide on a college and putting a lot of stress on her to do well because she is the oldest and the "example for everyone." She said, "What really helped was that I called LICC when I felt the need to cut and the **Counselors always helped me** find something else to do."

A Pride for Youth Social Worker worked with a I3 year-old transgender male client. He was able to provide individual counseling and outside resources that allowed this client, working with the parents, to achieve a legal name change and link them to transgender-affirming medical care.


"I know I could always count on LICC, You are true heroes!"
